

About DC

Discipleship Centre (DC) was established in the year 1974. Since then the organization is working towards sustainable development of marginalized communities at a national level. Our commitment is to initiate the community into proper living, standing for their rights with the power to step towards the development. Building up and polishing their capacities and skills to make for them a beautiful life.

In the past DC has responded to most of the disasters/calamities that have occurred in the country through immediate relief and assistance to the afflicted.

DC's work is always amongst the urban and the rural poor with a special focus on the needs of women and children.

Education- “Education is a gift that none can take away”

With the continued support of Tear Fund UK (TF-UK) Discipleship Centre was running a Child at Risk Project for the last 20 years and educated, trained and brought the skilful children of the slum areas of Kalyanpuri and Madanpur Khadar. 300 children were benefitted in this areas continually by getting the nutritious meal, hygienic materials, uniforms of the schools and so on.

The time has come to bid farewell to the children as the communities and CBOs along with Bal Panchayat, SHG are empowered to continue the centre and no question of sustainability is required. The communities and CBOs are monitored by Discipleship Centre to run the centre without any difficulties.



Cultural Program

Conducting Parent Teachers Meeting with the parent and staff of DC is a motivating factor for the children and parents. Through motivation the school authority has recently chosen 5 parents in Madanpur Khadar and 2 parents in Kalyanpuri to participate in the respective school's Monitoring Committee. Youth children are encouraged to network with the local police and are very active. Recently there were 2 children missing from their respective home and the youth took up the matter to police station and traced the two missing children and handed over to the parents.

The parents were so happy and thankful to DC for the training and education imparted to the youths. Adolescent girls training are regularly being conducted by the help of Delhi Police in the slum and the Delhi Police are imparting training in the field of Child Safety, Human trafficking and career guidance.

Health awareness – “It is health that is real wealth”

In the education creating and teaching health awareness is yet another factor that the children are benefitted. Health awareness includes knowing seasonal

diseases, HIV/AIDS, TB (Tuberculosis) and other diseases. The second part of health awareness, where teachers are enabling the children to educate their parents and to diagnosis the disease and approach the hospital facilities like DOT Centre and take Government’s help too in TB and other diseases.

Livelihood – “Earning of livelihood by following some profession is better than living on charity”

CBOs are regularly networking with MCD (Municipal Corporation of Delhi), Jal Board. CBOs are approaching the Counsellor of the respective area and MLA of the state Government.

Youths are trained in YMCA centre of both the projects in computer course, tally, and English speaking course and to how to earn the livelihood. DC has recommended children to take training @50% fee concession in YMCA. YMCA at Kalyanpuri has trained the youths in tailoring and other related courses as well.

Self Help Group (SHG) members in Madanpur Khadar opened saving bank accounts in HDFC bank and Kalyanpuri members opened in State Bank of India to enroll and to plan their livelihood through small savings. SHG members are promoting the function of Swachh Bharat in their locality. SHG members and CBOs have guided the community to get Aadhar Card, Voter ID, Birth certificates, pension etc from the State Government. The other Government schemes like Sukanya, Ladli yojana etc, are also put forward by the CBOs and SHG to the community.



Cultural Program

Moral Development –

“Good values are like magnets and attract only good things.” Organized regular summer camp for the project children. All the children participated in the camp and learnt moral values through action songs and stories. Summer camp helped the children to grow spiritually after learning the title of “Good Friends”.

On 12th and 13th December 2019, Christmas celebrations were conducted amongst the project children.

Community people, CBOs participated in the function and expressed their grief as DC is exiting from the Centre. Christmas program was celebrated with enthusiasm and zeal with children and community. Children enacted the nativity play, skits, dance and songs. The Christmas message was shared about the Love of God. We handed over all the functioning of the project to the community chosen members.

DC is thanking Tearfund for the support extended so far for the community to lead a basic standard of life and their children’s growth.

Case study – Community Development

“Mrs. Sushma, 36 years old is living in 21/38, Kalyanpuri, Delhi with her husband and two children (1 daughter and 1 son) since 1998. After her marriage she stayed with her in-laws but her husband and in-laws were not supportive. Husband is an alcoholic and during her pregnancy period they did not take care of her. Many days she did not get food. The community in which she stays are



very illiterate. Her husband used to abuse her daily. She is a very quiet and soft lady. She was very discouraged and upset. Lastly she informed her brother and stayed separately with her two children. In 2016 Sushma came to our office searching for a job; DC employed her as a helper for kitchen. Her two children started to come to our centre for study. After six month she has been promoted as a cook. She is very hard worker and faithful. After joining at our office she slowly attended our devotion and she shared her problems to our staff for prayers. She is slowly growing in faith and started staying happily with her children. Her children are also obedient and are studying well. God has blessed her abundantly and anointed her with the power of Holy Spirit. God has changed her life completely. In October 2018 suddenly her husband Mr. Rakesh came back to her and asked her forgiveness. Mrs. Shusma happily forgiven.

Her son Tushar Studying in class 7th and daughter Gunjan is in class 4th.

By God's Grace now both Mrs. Sushma and Mr. Rakesh are happily living together with two children. Mrs. Sushma always used to say God is great and loving God. The Lord has brought great changes in her life. She desires that her children should grow spiritually and study well.

We praise God for answering our prayers. Day by day Mrs. Sushma is slowly and steadily growing in faith.

Food, Nutrition and Education to the orphan children

"We cannot help everyone, but everyone can help someone".

Discipleship Centre selected 300 semi orphan children for education with the sponsorship of Missionary Service Committee (MSC), Canada in Kalyanpuri and Madanpur Khadar. MSC is supporting this project since 1999.

Children are regularly attending government school after taking one time nutritious meal from our centre. The children are very happy to attend the centre for studies, which they are enjoying. Children who are attending our centre are scoring very good marks.



Case study – Food and Nutrition

Teena, 11 years old, girl who resides in Kalyanpuri was very weak. Her father works as a Mason but he is a drunkard. Parents are not interested to send her to school. But her grandparents support her study. Five year ago our project staff visited her house and counselled her parents and conveyed them about importance of education. Continuous counseling led parents who agreed to send her to our centre. After coming to our centre we taught her Hindi, English alphabets and she has improved in her studies. Now she is good in her studies.

Mid day meal served in our centre helps her to be healthy. Now she is grown and participating in all activities. She is always wishing to come to centre for study. Our staff and counsellor always encouraged her in all respects. She wants to become a Teacher.

Akash a 12 year old boy lives in Kalyanpuri with his parents and brother. His father works as a Security guard. He was a very naughty and aggressive child when our staff met him at his home in the year 2016. Through our continuous follow up he agreed to come to our Centre. His naughty behavior was changed by taking moral studies. Now he is a very good child in our centre. His parents are very happy and thanked DC for his behavioral changes.

Through our mid day meal he has improved his health. Now he is studying in 8th standard. He is very active in extracurricular activities also.

Teachers have been appointed to teach the children and guide them to grow as disciplined children. Mr. Sam's desire that children should study well and have a standard life, and as DC is supporting for the children's development. He is a great person who shows interest to help the poorest children in the slum areas.



Case study – Sam Anastas's sponsor child

Arjun, a 12 year boy is residing in Kalyanpuri with his parents. He has 2 brothers and one sister. His father is a daily wage labourer. He was a malnourished child and was having breathing problem. Our project staff met him and invited him to our centre. First he came for nutritious mid day meal in DC's Centre. Through this, his health becomes better and now he is free from breathing problem. 2 years back, Mr. Sam selected him as his sponsor child. Through this sponsorship he and his family are getting support like hygienic materials, grocery item, study material and clothing. He and his family are thankful to Mr. Sam for the great help.

Rinky a 14 year old girl, is living in Kalyanpuri with her parents. She has 3 sisters and one brother. Her father is a labourer and her mother works as a maid. In 2015 our staff met her and she was in a disturbed condition, because of her family's condition. Our staff counselled her and encouraged her to come to our Centre. Through continuous counselling, she came to our centre. She was very weak in her studies. Due to the staff intervention she improved in her studies. Now she is studying in 9th standard. Our nutritious mid day meal helps her to improve her health physically. Through teaching she is developed morally as well.

Mr. Sam sponsored her and she is getting grocery, hygiene materials, study materials and clothing. She is so happy along with her family. They are so thankful to the sponsor.


